

Immediate Dentures/Partials

You are preparing for the placement of an immediate denture/partial. This means that a denture/partial will be placed at the same time as the removal of one or more of your natural teeth. This allows for you to have replacement teeth right away. The alternative would be to go without teeth for several weeks while your denture/partial is fabricated.

Normal Follow-up Care

After approximately 2 - 6 months of wearing your denture/partial we will refit (reline) it. You will be without your denture/partial for approximately 24 hours. It is necessary to refit (reline) them to compensate for the healing that takes place after the extraction(s). There is an additional fee for the refitting (reline) per denture/partial. This sometimes is not covered by your insurance so you would be responsible for the fee. On occasion (10% of the time) refitting (relining) is inadequate to obtain a well fitting denture/partial. In these cases a new denture/partial needs to be fabricated. The fee for this treatment is additional to the immediate denture/partial and is not covered by insurance. You would be responsible for this fee.
