TEMPORARY CROWNS/BRIDGES

We have placed a temporary restoration for you. This is an interim treatment until your crown/bridge is completed, It is important that you follow the following guidelines to prevent your temporary crown from coming off prior to the placement of your crown/bridge.

Please avoid the following foods/items:

- gum chewing
- hard candy/ice
- sticking foods i.e.: taffy
- Flossing that area for now. If it is necessary to floss due to food impaction, carefully pull floss through the side. Do not pull up.
- Chewing on the side or area of the mouth with the temporary crown or bridge. Try to favor other side if possible.

What to do if temporary crown/bridge is loose or falls off:

- Attempt to place back onto the tooth (it may stay) and call our office to schedule a recementation appointment.
- We have provided a complementary temporary cement to place your temporary back onto your tooth. Instructions are on the back. Please call us during office hours to re-cement it.
- Please do not use "Crazy glue" or other types of temporary cements.
